Our "*Washed Stone*" products have a high sub-angularity, which is a result of our washing & screening process and the "*Washed Drain Stone*" has minimal fines, as a result of our high quality washing & product processing. Our clean, non-leaching environmentally sound products are available to be delivered to you by truck or they can be shipped directly to your project site by barge using the Fraser River Waterways System.
